

#### **VACCINE MANDATE GUIDANCE ISSUED BY CMS**

January 1, 2021: On December 28, 2021 CMS released a QSO-22-07-All which is a memorandum to State Survey Agencies outlining the process for surveying RHC/FQHCs on compliance with the Vaccine Mandate.
